

for September 2016 as presented. Commissioner Connolly seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Finance Director Fosselman has begun projections for the budget process using the nine months of data this year. The Budget Meetings have been advertised for next Tuesday and Wednesday, October 18 & 19, beginning at 5 PM. An additional meeting, if needed, is scheduled for Wednesday, October 26. The meetings are open to the public.

Mr. Fosselman also discussed the requirements under the SEC to file an EMMA report by October 1. The report was filed on time and is now on schedule for filing at the correct time each year. Commissioner Chiavetta questioned if the Susquehanna Group notified the Township of this requirement. Mr. Fosselman said he has not had any contact with them for a while.

- B. Chief of Police Report: Chief Umberger reported on the police activities for the month of September. Officers handled a total of 1,511 calls for service. A breakdown of calls is shown on the monthly report posted on the bulletin board.

The full report of police activities in schools, with juvenile and adult probation checks, and other community events is also posted.

The 4th Annual Hero Run is set for Sunday, November 6, at the Harrisburg Mall.

The Youth Advisory Council met at C.D. East High School on October 5, with 39 students and about 58 total participants. The next meeting will be at Milton Hershey School sometime in December.

Trick-or-Treat Night in the Township will be Thursday, October 27. Chief Umberger said this date is set by the Police Chief's Association as the fourth Thursday in October. There is some discussion about celebrating it on Halloween, no matter which night of the week it falls on. Chief Umberger will be discussing this with the other Chief's.

The Police Department has been notified they will be receiving a grant for the School Resource Officer. He will have further information on this next month.

The Citizens' Police Academy will start January 16, 2017. Interested persons can apply on the Police website.

Commissioner Connolly moved to approve the request of Jermain McQueen for an internship with the Police Department subject to completion of the necessary waivers. Commissioner Milakovic seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Connolly moved to approve Rebekah Carpenter and Lizangel Pilier for one to three day ride-alongs with the Police Department subject to completion of the necessary waivers. Commissioner Milakovic seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

- C. Fire Services Report: Fire Services Director Ibberson said the Fire Services report is not available because of updates being done at the County system.

The report will be sent to the Board as soon as it is available, and a copy of the detailed report will be posted on the bulletin board in the lobby.

- D. Finance Report: Treasurer Fosselman informed the Board of some major expenditures in September: over \$701,000 in bond payments; \$251,000 principal payment on a fire truck payoff; and over \$600,000 in pension payments for uniformed and non-uniformed employees.
9. Resolution - Street Dedication-Chatham Glenn Way & Knapp Drive: Commissioner Milakovic moved to approve Resolution R-2016-37 (full text available in Township Resolution Book) accepting the dedication for the above named streets contingent upon the payment of outstanding engineering fees in the amount of \$2,937.01. Commissioner Connolly seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.
10. Resolution - Chestnut Alley Sinkhole Repair: Commissioner Milakovic moved to approve Resolution R-2015-38 (full text available in Township Resolution Book) authorizing the negotiation, execution and signature authority of all correspondence and documents related to the acquisition of right-of-way for the Chestnut Alley sinkhole repair project. Commissioner Connolly seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.
11. Acceptance of Resignation and Appointment to Vacancy-Sewer Authority Board: Commissioner Chiavetta moved to accept the resignation of Fredrick Cabell from the Sewer Authority Board. Commissioner Connolly seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.
Commissioner Boudier moved to appoint Richard Bowra to fill the term on the Sewer Authority. Commissioner Chiavetta seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously. There was discussion about where Mr. Bowra resides not being in the same ward as the member he is replacing.
12. Subdivision/Land Development Plans:
A. Improvement Guarantee Release- Chatham Glenn, Phase XVI: Commissioner Chiavetta moved to approve release of the improvement guarantee for Chatham Glenn, Phase XVI, releasing the balance of \$495.00 as recommended by the Township Engineer. Commissioner Milakovic seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

16. Commissioners Requests & Comments:

Commissioner Moyer-- had questions about follow-up on the Ivy Ridge recreation bond money. Manager LeBlanc said the work has been done, but the invoice has not been paid yet.

Commissioner Moyer said he lauds the at-large appointment of a Sewer Authority member.

Commissioner Boudier-- had no comments at this time.

Commissioner Connolly-- reported a problem at Ivy Ridge where it looks like a post was hit by a vehicle. It is located close to the pavilion.

Commissioner Connolly attended Lawnton's Open House which was very impressive with a smoke house, vehicle rescue demonstration, and hose station. He thanked all the fire personnel in attendance and noted there will be other fire service events in the community this month.

Commissioner Milakovic-- had no comments at this time.

Commissioner Chiavetta-- thanked the Chief and Fire Marshal for assistance in traffic control at St. Catherine's for the upcoming funeral of Msgr. Topper who died at the age of 104.

He also alerted Chief Umberger to some media coverage at the Paxtang Halloween Parade on October 25.

The Fire Marshal will not be available on Tuesday for his portion of the Budget meeting so Finance Director Fosselman will be handling his budget presentation.

Commissioner Varner-- had no comments at this time.

President Troxell-- reiterated the Budget Meeting dates of Tuesday and Wednesday, October 18 & 19, beginning at 5 PM, and a meeting on Wednesday, October 26, if necessary. The meetings are open to the public.

17. Adjournment: Commissioner Connolly moved to adjourn, seconded by Commissioner Milakovic and carried unanimously. The Regular Meeting II adjourned at 7:45 PM.
