

1. Call to Order: The Regular Meeting I of the Swatara Township Board of Commissioners was called to order by President Troxell at 7:00 PM on Wednesday, May 3, 2017, at the Township Administration Building, 599 Eisenhower Blvd., Swatara, PA 17111.
2. Pledge of Allegiance: President Troxell led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Invocation: President Troxell gave the invocation.
4. Roll Call: Commissioners Boudier, Chiavetta, Connolly, Milakovic, Moyer, Troxell and Varner were present. Also present: Township Manager LeBlanc, Assistant Manager Kaufman, Solicitor Wyland, Secretary Rubinic, Fire Marshal Ibberson, Tax Collector Donato, and Sgt.-at-Arms and Deputy Chief Reider.
5. Executive Session: President Troxell announced an Executive Session was held prior to tonight's meeting to discuss a Personnel Matter.

9. Visitors' Requests & Comments:
Joe Donato, Township Tax Collector--said he had put some numbers together on the tax increase that would be needed to fund the debt service on the proposed Municipal Campus. An additional \$2.5 million in taxes would be needed each year to fund a \$30 million bond; this translates to a resident now paying \$50 in debt service would have to pay \$237 to \$250 per year for 20 years.
