

The Swatara Township Board of Commissioners held a Public Hearing on the proposed amendment to Chapter 295 of the Zoning Ordinance on Wednesday, May 2, 2018, at 7:15 p.m., at the Swatara Township Administration Building, 599 Eisenhower Boulevard, Harrisburg, PA 17111.

Members of the Board present were: Commissioners Varner, Connolly, Troxell, Zubeck and Boudier. Also present: Manager Fosselman, Assistant Manager Kaufman, Solicitor Coccorese, Director of Planning and Zoning Ihlein, and Acting Secretary Alleman.

Coccorese: This is the time, date and place advertised for a public hearing to consider the adoption of an ordinance amending Chapter 295 of the Swatara Township Code, which is the Zoning Ordinance, which would revise the language and add sections relating to funeral homes and crematoriums. My name is Steve Coccorese, I guess I was the kid that was invited to play the part of the Solicitor, Scott Wyland. With that being said, is there any public comment on the ordinance at this time?

Coccorese: Hearing no public comment Commissioners, I'll turn it over to you. I would just need a motion to accept that ordinance.

Connolly: I will make a motion that we accept an ordinance amending Chapter 295 of the Swatara Township Zoning Ordinance, by revising and adding sections relating to funeral homes and crematoriums.

Troxell: I second the motion.

Connolly: We have a motion and second, is there any discussion? Hearing none, I'll call the vote. All those in favor of the motion say aye.

Connolly: Any one opposed? (No replies) Okay, the ordinance passes unanimously. (This is Ordinance 2018-03, full text available in Township Ordinance book)

Coccorese: That concludes the hearing portion of the evening's events.
