10. Award of Merit – Lt. Thomas Stauffer: Lt. Stauffer was presented with an award for recognition of his diligent and outstanding work for being solely in charge of the patrol division over the last nine years.
11. Presentation of Civilian Support Award – Susan Spoljaric: Chief of Police Reider presented Susan Spoljaric with a Civilian Support Award for helping a neighbor who was a victim of domestic violence and in need of assistance.
12. Presentation of K-9 Support Check: Representative Thomas Mehaffie, who is a business owner in the township, presented Chief Reider with a check in the amount of \$1,000 on behalf of Breski Beverage for the K-9 program. Representative Mehaffie presented K-9 Kix with a Proclamation from the House of Representatives.
13. Presentation of Gaming Grant Check for K-9 Support: A check is forthcoming from the County in the amount of \$13,000 for the K-9 program.
14. Presentation of Grant from Violent Crimes Task Force: District Attorney Fran Chardo awarded \$59,893.58 to the K-9 program from the Violent Crimes Task Force.

Chief Reider thanked the Board of Commissioners for allowing the K-9 program to start again. He thanked the community as well for their generous support of the program.

15. Introduction of Girl Scout Junior Troop 10734: President Connolly presented each member of the Troop with a Certificate for participating in the Earth Day Cleanup at the Capital Area Greenbelt.
16. Consideration of Minutes:
 - A. Regular Meeting II – March 14, 2018: Commissioner Boudier made a motion to approve the minutes of March 14, seconded by Commissioner Troxell. Commissioner Zubeck voted no. Motion carried.
 - B. Regular Meeting I – May 2, 2018: Commissioner Troxell made a motion to approve the minutes of May 2, seconded by Commissioner Boudier. Motion carried unanimously.

C. Public Hearing – May 2, 2018: Commissioner Troxell made a motion to approve the public hearing of May 2, seconded by Commissioner Boudier. Motion carried unanimously.

17. Visitors' Requests & Comments:

A. Jacob Bruker, 457 Pritchard Court: Mr. Bruker stated a new home was being built on a lot beside his residence, 467 Pritchard Court. He questioned the size of the lot, and understands it was grandfathered into the current zoning regulations. He would have liked the Township to notify the residents that the new home was being constructed in his neighborhood. Robert Ihlein, Director of Zoning, said the lot in question was a vacant, viable lot. The builder met all zoning requirements to construct a home on the site. President Connolly asked Mr. Ihlein to check into the matter and stay apprised of the construction.

B. Charles Scollon, Parishioner of Saint Cathrine Laboure Church, 4000 Derry Street: Asked the board if they had any questions or concerns he could answer regarding Agenda Item 21, Sign and Marking Improvements at St. Catherine Laboure Church. Commissioner Zubeck said she was in touch with Chief Reider regarding the request. Chief Reider said the concerns of the Church were approved.

18. Reports: President Connolly let the audience know that Local Government Day was held on May 2 and the monthly reports were presented at that time.

A. Manager's Report: Manager Fosselman said he met with the Township Engineer, PennDOT, and Commissioners Connolly and Zubeck regarding Route 322 and the six-legged intersection at Hummelstown Hill. Commissioner Zubeck said Federal monies are being made available for such projects.

B. Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Fosselman presented the Treasurer's Report for the month of April (attached). Commissioner Troxell made a motion to accept the report as presented, seconded by Commissioner Boudier. Motion carried unanimously.

C. Solicitor's Report: No report

D. Fire Services Report: Director of Fire and Emergency Services Ibberson gave a brief update regarding the recent incident on the Susquehanna River. There is about 10 miles of the Susquehanna River in Swatara Township.

E. Community Service Report: Chief Reider presented a brief community service report regarding April activities.

19. Removal of Special Purpose Parking Area at 6851 Huntingdon Street:

Commissioner Troxell made a motion to eliminate the special purpose area at 6851 Huntingdon Street, seconded by Commissioner Boudier. Motion carried unanimously (R-2018-22)

20. Consideration of Resolution: Special Purpose Parking Area at 410 North 67th Street: Commissioner Troxell made a motion to place a special purpose parking area at 410 North 67th Street, seconded by Commissioner Boudier. Motion carried unanimously (R-2018-23)
21. Consideration of Sign and Marking Improvements at St. Catherine Laboure Church: Commissioner Zubeck made two motions, one to establish a no parking zone on the east side of North 40th Street as outlined in the Resolution (R-2018-24) and the second to establish a pedestrian crosswalk on North 40th Street as outlined in the Resolution (R-2018-25). Both motions were seconded by Commissioner Troxell. Motions carried unanimously.
22. Appointment of Assistant Secretary – Karen Alleman: Commissioner Boudier made a motion to appoint Karen Alleman as Assistant Secretary, seconded by Commissioner Troxell. Motion carried unanimously (R-2018-26).
23. Budget Revisions: President Connolly made a motion to table item 23, seconded by Commissioner Troxell. Motion carried unanimously.
24. Responsibilities and Wage Adjustments: President Connolly made a motion to table item 24, seconded by Commissioner Troxell. Motion carried unanimously.
25. Consideration of Agreement for Stormwater Manager - Tom Wilson: Commissioner Troxell made a motion to enter into an agreement with Tom Wilson to provide NPDES MS4 engineering services to the Township. Motion seconded by Commissioner Connolly. Motion carried unanimously.
26. Subdivision/Land Development Plans:
A. Preliminary/Final Subdivision Plan for Paramjit Singh and Huan Le: this property is located at 813 South 29th Street and 2810 Pazxton Street. It is a minor plan that proposes to take three existing lots and re-subdivide, recombine and reconfigure them into two different lots. The plan was reviewed and approved by the Township Planning Commission.
a. Approval of waiver from Section 253.11 of the Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance that requires the submittal of a preliminary plat. Commissioner Troxell made a motion to approve this waiver, seconded by Commissioner Connolly. Motion carried unanimously.
b. Approval of a waiver from Section 253-14.A.17 of the Township Subdivision and Land Development ordinance that requires an erosion and sedimentation control plan. Commissioner Troxell made a motion to approve this waiver, seconded by Commissioner Boudier. Motion carried unanimously.

- c. Approval of a waiver from Section 253-26.A of the Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance requiring the setting of corner monuments. Commissioner Troxell made a motion to approve this waiver, seconded by Commissioner Boudier. Motion carried unanimously.
- d. Approval of a waiver from Section 253.32 of the Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance that requires sidewalks. Commissioner Troxell made a motion to approve this waiver, seconded by Commissioner Boudier. Motion carried unanimously.
- e. Approval of Resolution for conditional approval of the final plat dated April 9, 2018 as revised on April 20, 2018. Commissioner Zubeck made a motion to approve Resolution 2018-27, seconded by Commissioner Troxell. Motion carried unanimously.
