## 10. Reports

- A. Manager's Report: No report.
- B. <u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Commissioner Tuckey made a motion to approve the February 2023 Treasurer's Report as presented, seconded by Commissioner Varner. Motion carried unanimously.
- C. <u>Solicitor's Report:</u> Solicitor Hall discussed the following: 1) The Norfolk Southern tax appeal case has been scheduled for trial in July. 2) A recent trial was held regarding the Walmart property for a tax appeal matter. A decision has not been received yet. 3) In regard to Norfolk Southern litigation involving stormwater, Norfolk Southern has filed a counter claim, claiming they are not subject to the stormwater fee based upon the West Chester Case. We are awaiting a decision on the motion to remand to bring it back to Dauphin County Court of Common Pleas.

The Regular Meeting II of the Board of Commissioners recessed at 7:15 p.m. for a public hearing for Inter Municipal Liquor License Transfer of Tri-State UPA, LLC, 1002 Jefferson Drive, Middletown, PA. The Regular Meeting II of the Board of Commissioners reconvened at 7:18 p.m.

<u>Consideration of Resolution: Inter-Municipal Liquor License Transfer for Tri-State</u> <u>UPA, LLC</u>: Commissioner Varner made a motion to approve the Inter-Municipal Liquor License Transfer for Tri-State UPA, LLC. Commissioner Tuckey seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. This is Resolution R-2023-17.

- D. Swatara Rising Comprehensive Plan: Director Ihlein presented his report to the Board. PennDOT is driving a lot of things in the Township lately, the Route 322 and Chambers Hill interchange may be bid early next year. The I-83 and Eisenhower Interchange is causing some spin-off land development such as the Faulkner organization on Paxton Street. He has met with two additional affected property owners who are working hard to find suitable properties to remain in the Township. Sixteen applications just came in for demolition permits, mostly residential around 29<sup>th</sup> and Wayne Streets and 42<sup>nd</sup> and York Streets, south of Derry. Properties should be removed within the next month.
- E. <u>Fire Services/EMS Report</u>: There was no report this evening. Fire Chief Ibberson had to leave to respond to an emergency call.
- F. <u>Public Safety Report:</u> Deputy Chief Stauffer presented his report to the Board. A Senior Fair will be held on April 26 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the LCBC Church on Chambers Hill Road. Coffee With a Cop will be held tomorrow at 9 a.m. The Police Department's Annual Report is available.
