STORMWATER AUTHORITY

C. **892 Third Avenue:** There was a construction site meeting on Monday. Everything was relatively satisfactory. The former and current property owners understand what needs to be done. There is no need to press forward at this time with litigation.

Mr. Fosselman asked if stormwater fee bills should be mailed out. Solicitor Hall said the bills should be mailed out as usual.

8. **Members Requests and Comments:** Mr. Connolly asked what the Norfolk Southern case entailed. Mr. Hall said it was regarding stormwater and payment of the fee. Norfolk Southern feels they are not subject to the fee. Mr. Hall expects the outcome of the Supreme Court decision will have some impact on the outcome. Norfolk Southern also refuses to allow the township on their property. Mr. Connolly asked why there was a chalk line drawn on the property at 892 Third Avenue. Mr. Trafka said the line was there as reference for the sanitary sewer authority to access their manholes. Mr. Tuckey thanked staff for doing in-house stormwater fee billing.
